



Corporal Matthew Lembke Memorial Scholarships

These scholarships are dedicated to the memory of **Matt Lembke** and have been created through the joint efforts of Tualatin High School, Timberwolf Support Organization, and the Lembke Family. The scholarships are funded by the annual **Regatta Run**, and by generous donations of family, friends, and the community.

Applicants must attend Tualatin High School their **junior and senior** year, and graduate from Tualatin High School with plans to attend an accredited college or university.

Matt Lembke was an enthusiastic and optimistic person with a quick smile and a witty sense of humor. He was energetic and full of life. Matt loved the outdoors and played several sports, but football became his passion in high school, where he was given the nickname "Lump-E." Matt was a 2005 graduate of Tualatin High School who joined the Marine Corp shortly after graduation with the intent to become the best Marine he could be. He served two tours of duty in Iraq and extended his commitment to the Marine Corp in order to participate in a third tour in Afghanistan with plans to attend college in Oregon after completion of that deployment. Matt was critically injured while on patrol in Afghanistan in June of 2009 and succumbed to complications from the injuries and died on July 10, 2009.

In honor of Matt's character and service, this scholarship will be awarded to the applicant that most closely typifies the qualities of **honor, courage, commitment, and service to others.**
