

2021 Regatta Run COVID-19 Policy

The Regatta Run is a collaborative effort between the Rotary Club of Tualatin and the City of Tualatin. This event will be held on Saturday, October 16th. The course for the 5K Run/Walk is flat and user friendly. The Race will start and finish at the Tualatin Community Park. In addition to the run there will be a Business Showcase allowing Run sponsors an opportunity to interact with race participants. There will also be a trick-or-treat experience for children to enjoy.

COVID Prevention Plan

To reduce the potential for COVID-19 virus transmission among participants, organizers, and spectators, the following protocols will be followed:

- All activities associated with the Run, Business Show Case, and Trick-or-Treat experience will be held outdoors.
- Regardless of vaccination status, all participants, organizers, and volunteers will be required to wear face masks while in the park, at the start and finish lines, and while visiting the Business Showcase and Trick-or-Treat tables. Masks and hand sanitizer will be available at the sanitation stations throughout the event.
- Social Distancing guidelines will be advised and race starting times staggered to minimize concentrations of participants at the start/finish line and on the course.
- While participants will be advised to bring and wear a mask at the event, Sanitation Stations at the Start/Finish line and located on the course will provide masks and hand sanitizer to participants who may have forgotten or lost a mask.
- Volunteers will be stationed at the Business Showcase and at the Trick-or-Treat tables to provide masks and coordinate distancing guidelines.
